M.C. artist included in Chicago show, sale

CHICAGO — The ninth annual One of a Kind Show and Sale Chicago will be Dec. 3-6.

More than 500 artists, artisans and designers from across North America will showcase their work at The Merchandise Mart, including Mason City ceramist Jo Anne Willemsen.

“I create one-of-kind wood fire pottery,” Willemsen said in her artist’s statement. “I like to fire at high temperatures for 50-60 hours because of the effects of the ash that land on and then melt on the pottery, giving each piece its own signature from the kiln.”
